Web-Research Course Participants' Country Enrolment

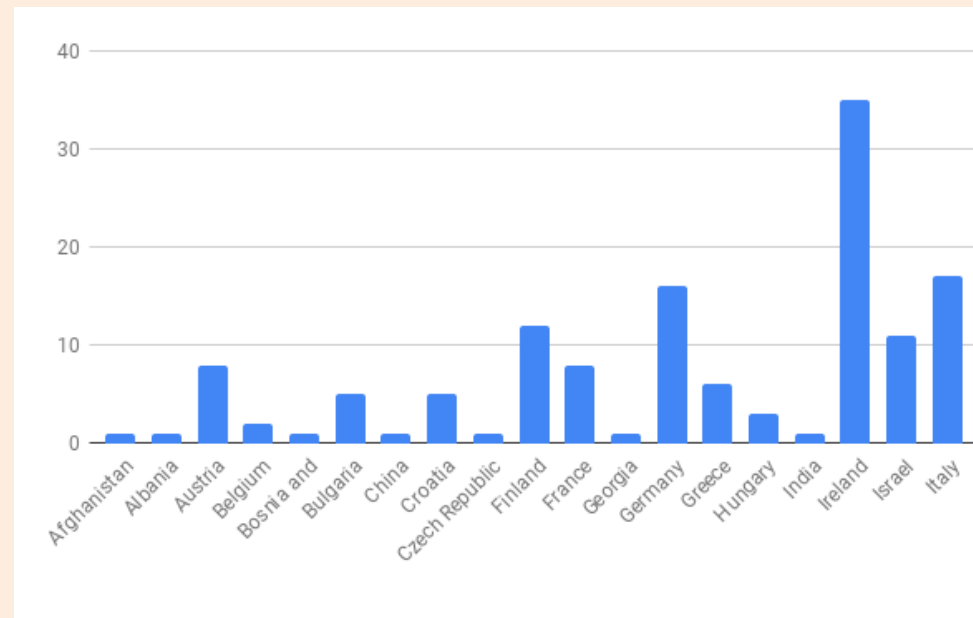
Total number of enrolment is 320.

Collaborative Projects

- The inSight study (PI: Ana Luisa Neves) involves 20 EGPRN countries. The topic is the impact of COVID-19 on the use of digital-first technologies in primary care. Data are analysed and the first paper (Protocol) was published in JMIR Res Protoc.
- Orenas group continues working (PI: Michael Harris) with two new research projects:
 - Empowerment of GPs for early detection of cancer: the first paper is being prepared
 - What inhibits GPs thinking or act on diagnosis of cancer - on the stage of very detailed qualitative analysis.
- IMOCAFV: The project reviews models of care for Family Violence in the participating countries and will define recommendations on how to facilitate implementation of good practice.
- Comprehensive list of all projects will be discussed at the RSC meeting
